There are special services at Easter, Harvest-Festival, All Souls etc, and especially around Christmas. We hold an annual Patronal Service in the middle of October, when we celebrate the role of the church in the life of the community. We host a variety of community events, including concerts, a plant & cake sale, a village safari supper, and a Lent Lunch, all of which are well attended by local people.
